Choices for music at your wedding

Music is one of the important aspects of a wedding. You may choose our organist to play music, your own musicians, or use a music source such as an Ipad/Ipod through our PA system.

If you choose organ music, the organist will select the music from the following unless you request something else that he agrees to play:

Before the Ceremony:	A selection from: Air (from <i>Water Music Suite</i>) - G. F. Handel Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring - J. S. Bach Largo - G. F. Handel Hymns such as: <i>Amazing Grace</i> , <i>O Perfect Love</i> <i>The Lord's My Shepherd</i> <i>A New Commandment</i>
Processional music:	As the church is small, only one piece of music will be required Bridal Chorus (from <i>Lohengrin</i>) - R. Wagner alternatively Trumpet Tune in D - H. Purcell
Musical Interlude (Signing of the Register):	As for "Before the Ceremony " If you want to have a soloist perform, may we suggest that this is the best time?
Recessional Music:	As the church is small, only one piece of music will be required Wedding March from <i>A Midsummer Night's Dream</i> F. Mendelssohn
